1. Objectives of the Conference

2. Conference Theme

- Theme of the conference: Researching, Teaching Vietnamese Studies and Vietnamese Language to Foreigners in the AI Era.

- Current research and teaching issues in Vietnamese studies and the Vietnamese language in the region and the world in the era of digital technology and artificial intelligence (AI);

- Vietnam in the region and the world today;
- Vietnamese education in the era of digital technology and artificial intelligence (AI).

- Venue: USSH-VNUHCM, 10-12 Dinh Tien Hoang Street, Saigon Ward, Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam;
- Format: in-person.

4. Submission guidelines

- Accepted languages: Vietnamese, English (preferred);
- Paper formatting requirements:

Submissions must present original research that has not been published in any form. Manuscripts should follow the American Psychological Association (APA), 7th edition, including citation style, footnotes, references, and related requirements;

- Review and publication process:

+ Submissions will be assigned to appropriate panels and undergo blind peer review prior to the conference;

+ Accepted papers will be edited and published in the Conference Proceedings with an ISBN;

+ After the conference, high-quality papers will be recommended for publication in appropriate Scopus-indexed journals or reputable domestic academic journals recognized by the State Council for Professor Title of Vietnam.

- + Notification of abstract acceptance: by May 03, 2026;
- + Full paper submission deadline: by May 24, 2026;
- + Review results: by June 07, 2026;
